EUROPEAN SOLIDARITY CORPS

The European Solidarity Corps is the new European Union initiative, which creates opportunities for young people to volunteer or work in projects - in their own country or abroad -that benefit communities and people around Europe.

Participants aged 18-30 can be placed with a project either for volunteering (formerly EVS) or for a traineeship, an apprenticeship or a job for a period between 2 weeks and 12 months usually located within the European Union Member States, however not limited to only these. Young people can get involved in a broad range of topics such as education, health, social integration, support for migrants and refugees, environmental protection, and plenty of other exciting and challenging areas.

After completing a simple registration process, European Solidarity Corps participants could be selected and invited to join a project.

With this program there is no sending organisation needed.

Activities and working methods in APAFF: Educational material: workshops about basic needs of companion animals, responsible ownership, importance of neutering and spaying, safety around pets, etc. Videos, games, role play, theatre, drawings, etc. Practical animal care: Feeding, giving water, cleaning bowls, poop scooping, changing bedding, washing dog houses, inspecting and reporting health or behavior issues, socializing and comforting the dogs; teaching dogs basic obedience commands and grooming them are some of the daily activities at the site. Arche Tirol is part of an international community of people with and without (multiple) disabilities, who live and work together in a rural surrounding 30 minutes from the capital Innsbruck. At the moment 10 people are living in two houses, one house is in Steinach and one is in St. Jodok am Brenner (few kilometers distance). Our main philosophy is not only taking care of them, but also to offer relationship and a home. The main tasks are care/nursing, household and creating a family-like and welcoming atmosphere for our core-members. We try to create a familiar atmosphere and to structure social life. We try to participate actively in the life of the local villages and stay in regular contact with the people and the public.
