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What is the European Solidarity Corps?



The European Solidarity Corps is the European Union initiative, which creates opportunities for young people to volunteer or work in projects - in their own country or abroad - that benefit communities and people around Europe.

Participants aged 18-30 can be placed with a project either for volunteering

(European Volunteer Service) or for a traineeship, an apprenticeship or a job for a period between 2 weeks and 12 months usually located within the European Union Member States, however not limited to only these. Young people can get involved in a broad range of topics such as education, health, social integration, support for migrants and refugees, environmental protection, and plenty of other exciting and challenging areas.

The skills that you gained during your volunteer service will be **certificated** with a **YouthPass**!

After completing a <u>simple registration</u> process on the **European Youth Portal**, European Solidarity Corps participants could be *selected and invited* to join a project **or** *apply* for a specific project themselves.

With this program there is no sending organisation needed, all costs

We gave you a selection of possible placements for your EVS, but to see all available opportunities for **ESC** you have to <u>register first</u>. But don't worry, it doesn't take long!:)

Long-term Volunteer Service (7 - 12 months)

Working for Nature in Nature, Czech Republic

<u>Duration:</u> 01/09/2020 to 31/08/2021 (12 months)

<u>Project Description:</u> Kaprálův mlýn is a scout environmental education centre situated in Moravian karst landscape protected area. Volunteering at Kaprálův mlýn consists of various activities: - assisting with the environmental education programmes (outdoor ecology for highschool students, outdoor activities, forest kindergarden), - helping with the operation of the centre (guest-care, cleaning, kitchen, info-shop duties), - working outside (looking after the garden, nature conservation work, preparing wood for winter, cutting the grass), - education (Czech lessons, workshops, NGO, environmental projects, conservation), - your own personal project. Duration of volunteer service for 6 or 12 months - depends on mutual agreement.

Volunteer in an alternative School / Schule im Pfeifferhof, Austria

<u>Duration:</u> 07/09/2020 to 09/07/2021 (10 months)

<u>Project description:</u> An alternative school "Schule im Pfeifferhof" is a non-profit institution initiated by parents for their children. The school was established by the association "Mit Kindern leben" in 1993. A team of eight teachers is responsible for education of 85 children. The school works according to reform-pedagogical principles (Montessori, Piaget), which means that the work is oriented at the needs and wishes of children. The learning methods are based on "practical" work and on projects. One of the principle of our school is "learning by doing". We try hard to prepare a surrounding for our children which enables them to make their own experiences, where they can do both, acquire cultural techniques and develop social competences. They also learn to handle rules and borders in a democratic way. Usually our children stay for nine years until they have finished their compulsary education. It is part of our philosophy to practice an intercultural exchange.

<u>Project description:</u> Tele Radio City is active on independent communication and information and socio-cultural events organization. It runs 5 websites and a web-radio: https://globalproject.info/, Meltingpot.org, Sherwood.it, Ecomagazine.info, Sportallarovescia.it, Radio Sherwood, focused on these themes: social movements, current affairs and political news, international politics, geopolitics, migration, citizenship rights, economy, political ecology, culture. Tele Radio City organizes the cultural event "Sherwood Festival" during the summer, a large independent music and culture event; it also runs other musical and cultural events throughout the year in several social spaces among the Northern-east Italy and especially in Padua head office. Volunteers may choose one or more activities among the following: web content writing, desk management, social network management, written or audio content's translation, radio broadcast's direction, podcasting, video-making, audio and video editing.

Volunteering in cultural centre, Italy

<u>Duration:</u> 01/01/2020 to 31/01/2021 (3 weeks)

<u>Project description:</u> Associazione Culturale Link is an association that wishes to promote non formal education, intercultural learning activities and human rights education. Link is a sending and hosting organisation for EVS and youth exchanges. The main activities of the project will be: 1 - reconstruction and cleaning of green areas of public library, removal of weeds, making of the wood stuff and furniture for the garden, cleaning of spaces and take care of the vegetable garden; 2 - support for the organization of cultural events to be carried out on the site: concerts, book presentations, events related to poetry, theater and movie (space preparation, event management, promotion, etc.); 3 - support in the promotion activities of the territory: walks for the knowledge of flora and fauna, visits to archaeological sites, organization of educational workshops for schools.

Be the change in 2020 as a summer animator, Poland

<u>Duration:</u> 20/06/2020 to 15/08/2020 (2 months)

<u>Project description:</u> This is a group activity focused on intercultural education, social animation and youth empowerment. It also aims at developing intercultural dialogue and understanding, as well as promoting positive thinking and tolerance. The project consists of two parts. In the first month the volunteers play the role of intercultural animators during the summer camp for children. They have the opportunity to create and implement their own ideas for creative and educative free time activities for local kids including intercultural education and communication in foreign languages. In the second part of the project the group designs and implements social animation events for the whole local community or selected groups with the theme "Happy Minsk". The actions depend on team's preferences and interests. The project is very intenstive and requires high level of commitment and responsibility from the volunteers.

ESC in VU Botanical garden, Lithuania

<u>Duration:</u> 10/06/2020 to 30/11/2020 (6 month)

<u>Project Description</u>: The Botanical Garden is interesting as an object of heritage – a part of an outbuilding of an old estate that has survived in Kairėnai, as well as the old park with ponds. A volunteer will take care of plants (flowers, wooded plants, lawns, garden plants, etc.). There are many simple tasks that are awaiting – hoe and rake soil, remove weeds, water plants, cut off old branches or flowers and inflorescences after blooming. After short training volunteer can start to propagate plants, to prune woody plants, help in data collection (for example to take photos for the database). The second area where volunteers can do a lot in dealing with visitors or with social network accounts of Garden. There is a possibility to help organize events (different technical activities – to prepare rooms, leaflets, information tables etc.), to help with guided tours in English, to help educators (assistance during Lithuanian educations, creation of new activities etc.).

Traineeships

Reducing unemployment among young people in Vilani district, Latvia

<u>Duration</u>: 01-05-2020 till 31-12-2020 **(8 months)**

Objectives

The project aims to create new jobs to reduce youth unemployment in Vilani County. The project aims to promote employment, eliminate all forms of discrimination and inequalities in the labor market, as well as to develop human resources and to promote an informed society. The challenge for LPK "Vilani" is to create a job for a young person who would like to work in his / her region and see opportunities for self-development so that he / she can later invest in the development of the company and the region.

Activities

The participants involved are young people from the Vilani Region who are unable to establish a long-term working relationship due to various socio-economic or geographical barriers. LPKS "Vilani" plans to involve two young people in the project by offering them full-time work for at least 6 months. Young people will be provided with all the necessary documentation to manage their employment.

Youth Exchanges

Youth exchanges allow groups of young people (13 - 30 age) from different countries to meet, live together and work on shared projects for short periods. Youth exchanges take place outside the school environment. On a youth exchange, you can expect to participate in activities such as workshops, exercises, debates, role-plays, outdoor activities and more.



Participants learning experiences are recognised through a Youthpass. Youth exchanges happen all around Europe all the time, the best way to be informed about new youth exchanges or any other youth work opportunities is through Facebook groups such as "Youth Exchanges for Europeans" or "Erasmus+ Projects".
