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What is the European Solidarity Corps?



The European Solidarity Corps is the European Union initiative, which creates opportunities for young people to volunteer or work in projects - in their own country or abroad - that benefit communities and people around Europe.

Participants aged 18-30 can be placed with a project either for volunteering

(European Volunteer Service) or for a traineeship, an apprenticeship or a job for a period between 2 weeks and 12 months usually located within the European Union Member States, however not limited to only these. Young people can get involved in a broad range of topics such as education, health, social integration, support for migrants and refugees, environmental protection, and plenty of other exciting and challenging areas.

The skills that you gained during your volunteer service will be certificated with a YouthPass!

After completing a <u>simple registration</u> process on the **European Youth Portal**, European Solidarity Corps participants could be *selected and invited* to join a project **or** *apply* for a specific project themselves.

With this program there is no sending organisation needed, all costs

We gave you a selection of possible placements for your EVS, but to see all available opportunities for **ESC** you have to <u>register first</u>. But don't worry, it doesn't take long! :)

Long-term Volunteer Service (7 - 12 months)

A Step Towards a Fair Future - Social Care, Bulgaria

<u>Duration:</u> 14/09/2020 to 14/09/2021 (12 months)

<u>Project Description:</u> Two projects in the region. 1.St Kiril and St Methodius Centre for Children at Risk in Kuklen 15km from the centre of Plovdiv. The centre organises daily recreational and educational activities and homework support for children, the majority of whom are from Roma families. A separate part of the centre is dedicated to specialised support for children with mental and physical disabilities. Volunteers will organise interactive activities for the children on subjects of their interest, which might include English language, sports, games and art; help staff to organise events and celebrations for different holidays; support the families and help to initiate activities together with the parents of the children. 2.Home Care, Plovdiv. Volunteers will accompany Caritas's nurses and social workers on home visits to elderly people, providing a combination of practical support and also conversation and friendship to these people, who are mostly very isolated due to long term health conditions.

Planet4youth. Work with adults with mental disabilities, Lithuania

<u>Duration:</u> during the period **01/09/2019** to **31/07/2021 (12 months)**

<u>Project Description:</u> Group is dedicated to integrate and assist mentally challenged and disabled people and their families. Also there are organized educating and leisure activities. The volunteer participates in all activities with disabled, helps individually, goes together to shop, assists in cooking, helps in a work sessions. After disabled people leave the volunteer has a day evaluation together with worker. Volunteers participate in a city events, retreats, summer camps, work camps, are leading person for disabled when they go to basketball match, concerts, theatres, cafe in the city. All tasks will be discussed with volunteers to find the best way for volunteers and organization. Any initiative of volunteers will be encouraged and supported to help our organization to develop. Volunteering with Peter McVerry Trust, Ireland

<u>Duration:</u> 05/09/2020 to 04/09/2021 (12 months)

Project description: Peter McVery Trust (PMVT) offers 12 month ESC placements, where volunteers have the opportunity to work in a number of different adult residential and/or day services in Dublin. Volunteers work a 35 hours week, participating in a range of activities such as aiding with the upkeep of the service and informally shadowing staff. Volunteers' main task is to informally engage with, help and befriend service users (while always maintain professional boundaries), which is particularly important work given the marginalizing nature of homelessness. As well as benefiting our service users, this allows volunteers to gain a greater understanding of homelessness and drug abuse, seeing this important topics from a new perspective. PMVT is also happy to support volunteers in setting up individual projects, where appropriate, to aid their service users, therefore we search for proactive, creative volunteers. <u>Duration</u>: during the period of **01/06/2020** to **31/05/2021 (12 months)**

<u>Project description</u>: De Zande is a juvenile detention center for boys and girls between 12 and 18 years old. The youngsters are placed here by the juvenile court, because of a living situation that is unbearable, or because they committed a crime. The boys and girls go through a pedagogical and didactic-educational program. We provide tailored guidance for every youngster who enters our facility. The result we have in mind is to facilitate the learning opportunities for the young people in our institutions and on the other hand for the volunteers. We want our young people to get the chance to learn from the volunteers by talking, exchanging experiences and by being able to see an example of taking part in the society in a positive way. The volunteer will be an example for the youngster in everyday activities.

In regards to this aim the teachers work very closely with the parents, and with other initiatives who undertake similar projects, and prepare the proper environment and activities. The volunteer will have the oportunity to participate creatively supporting the teacher (without responsibility regarding the children care): he/she will collaborate creating toys, furniture, or different material for children. She will participate in annual parties that we celebrate, she will support the teacher taking care of our vegetable garden and garden, where she will be able to learn the skills necessary for taking care of them. It performs the traditional role of the library and conducts activities in the field of culture and education aimed at different age groups. 2 volunteers will be supporting the staff in preparation and running activities aimed at the readers and inhabitants. They will also have opportunity to realise own initiatives, especially the ones adding intercultural dimension. Examples of tasks: supporting events promoting reading such as excursions, workshops, concerts; organising educational activities such as language cafes, handicraft workshops, STEM workshops; meetings with fairy tales for disabled children; taking photos and creating articles. Own initiatives will depend on volunteers' skills and experiences. In summer the volunteers can run a workcamp.

<u>Project description:</u> Role and tasks of volunteers are 1. Producing informative materials regarding promotion of a healthy lifestyle through sports activities and outdoor activities. The activity will take place on two groups, and the volunteers supported by the ASG staff will produce videos and audio materials, flyers, stickers, posters, etc. All these materials created in the first month of the EVS stage will be uploaded to the project web page and will be broadcast in the regional press via VTV and Valcea 1 TV channels, but also promoted in online social media: Facebook. 2. Recent years have seen a burgeoning interest in social entrepreneurship across Europe, strongly driven by a growing recognition of a key role social enterprises can play in tackling societal and environmental challenges and fostering inclusive growth. EU commission has published a report on Entrepreneurial learning in July 2017 (http://bit.ly/2w1SCYU). The training "Entrepreneurial Approaches for Youth Workers - EAYOW" aims to clarify and promote the concept of social entrepreneurship among NGOs and young people including those with fewer opportunities, to open social enterprises on NGOs' base and to prepare youth workers, youth trainers and youth leaders to deliver trainings and other educational activities on social entrepreneurship to NGOs and young people including those with fewer opportunities in their home countries and internationally. This course is being implemented in the framework of the STAR project – Stand Together Against Racism, which is a 3-year collaboration among 4 partners from Spain, Italy, Bulgaria, and Poland, with the aim to counter invisible racism and other forms of intolerance in the everyday lives of young people, including hate speech, through preventive measures, youth work, and non-formal education. Within 2 years of the project, the partner organisations worked with young people on the local level testing and upscaling approaches and tools, and in the last year of the project, we aim to share them with youth work practitioners by implementing this international training course, developing the manual and the MOOC – Massive Open Online Course.

Youth exchanges take place outside the school environment. On a youth exchange, you can expect to participate in activities such as workshops, exercises, debates, role-plays, outdoor activities and more.



Participants learning experiences are recognised through a Youthpass. Youth exchanges happen all around Europe all the time, the best way to be informed about new youth exchanges or any other youth work opportunities is through Facebook groups such as "Youth Exchanges for Europeans" or "Erasmus+ Projects".
