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What is the European Solidarity Corps?



The European Solidarity Corps is the European Union initiative, which creates opportunities for young people to volunteer or work in projects - in their own country or abroad - that benefit communities and people around Europe.

Participants aged 18-30 can be placed with a project either for volunteering

(European Volunteer Service) or for a traineeship, an apprenticeship or a job for a period between 2 weeks and 12 months usually located within the European Union Member States, however not limited to only these. Young people can get involved in a broad range of topics such as education, health, social integration, support for migrants and refugees, environmental protection, and plenty of other exciting and challenging areas.

The skills that you gained during your volunteer service will be **certificated** with a **YouthPass**!

After completing a <u>simple registration</u> process on the **European Youth Portal**, European Solidarity Corps participants could be *selected and invited* to join a project **or** *apply* for a specific project themselves.

With this program there is no sending organisation needed, all costs

Long term Volunteer Service (7 - 12 months)

Language ACTS 2 Romania

<u>Duration:</u> 01/08/2020 to 01/02/2021 (7 months)

<u>Project Description:</u> The project is designed to be the continuation, improvement and expansion of the pilot Language ACTS project that helped the organisation develop a methodology of using non-formal activities for the development of languages and cultural competencies. General Objective: Develop language competences and intercultural awareness for both 12 volunteers and 160 beneficiaries by using non-formal methods. the volunteers who apply for this project need to like and be willing to work with youth for 6 months. - active, open-minded, creative, innovative, responsible and motivated volunteers - the volunteers of this project should, above all else, show willingness to learn and see their EVS experience as a learning process.

Youth Empowerment, 3 volunteers, Sweden

<u>Duration</u>: 01/10/2020 to 30/06/2021 (9 months)

Project Description: Activity 1 One volunteer will be working with activities for refugees. The target groups are firstly asylum seekers who are in the process of waiting for the result of their asylum application, and secondly refugees who already got a residency permit and who are building a new life in Sweden. The activities can vary from cooking, dancing, learning languages, sport, arts and craft for children. The volunteer is encouraged to plan and lead activities depending on their own interests. Activity 2 Two volunteers will be working at Youth Centres run by the municipality. Supported by youth leaders and activity leaders, they will plan and lead leisure activities that can gather young people 13-25 years old with different backgrounds. The focus is on creating, cultural expressions and therefore it is a plus if the volunteer has some previous experience or a passion for creative activities, for example art, craft, theatre or music. Since the volunteers will be interacting with people in various activities it is required that they have good social skills. They should also have an interest in working with children and/or teenagers. They need to speak English and / or Swedish. We are looking for young people who are interested in alternative ways to knowledge and who seek an experience that will help them grow as people and add to their development towards education or a a career path.

ZSOI nr 7 Kindergarten - Solidarity - built to last, Poland

<u>Duration</u>: between **01/10/2020 to 30/06/2021 (9 months)**

Project description: Kindergarten is situated in the southern district of Cracow. In kindergarten, we take care of children in 5 age groups from 3 till 6 years old. We work 5 days weekly, from 8 am till 16 pm. The schedule organized activities take part till 15:00. Each group of children is led by 2 teachers or 3 teachers in the class where kids have some special needs. In each group, there are around 30 children. A teacher plans the activities for the group and then consult them during regular staff meetings. We try to provide for children many different activities (both group and personal ones), from sports and dancing, to handcrafts, painting etc. We also organize extra activities - English language, gymnastics, dancing, rehabilitation exercises for children who need it. The most important thing for us is to give children appropriate educational basics and as much knowledge and possibilities to do interesting things as possible.It is imperative to know that the most important is to ensure children's safety and the best conditions for their development.

<u>Project description:</u>: Kindergarten is situated in the southern part of Cracow. In kindergarten, we take care of 7 groups of children from 3 to 6 years old. We work 5 days a week from 6 am to 5 pm. During pre-school daycare, children have a lot of organized schedule activity. Each group is looked after by two teachers. We have 20/25 children in each group. We care about the overall development of children, so we organize for them many additional activities such as dance, art workshops, rhythmics, English, and many programs created by our teachers. We often go on trips to various interesting places to give children start learning about the Word. The most important for us is the safety of children and also creating opportunities for them to develop their own interests, creativity, and expand their skills. We want to cooperate with very responsible, creative, and open-minded volunteers. A volunteer should be very patient, good if he has any talents that he can share with children, should be able to cooperate in a team, be friendly, and have ease in making new contacts.

Helping with the recovery of the injured birds: feeding 4-times a day the little birds, helping with the preparation for examination, moving birds from cages to other cages (because of cleaning or examination), helping with the cleaning of cages, changing water, feeding, releasing birds back to nature. This project is planed for young people with fewer opportunities, who are facing different difficulties in their lives (social, economic, educational, territorial), NEET unemployed, minorities, low-level or unfinished education, family or economic problems, etc. There is no need for a good or any command of English. Maker Education in youth work
